

## **Coming to The Meeting House for Meeting for Worship during Covid 19 restrictions.**

The Re-opening Group have worked extremely hard to ensure your safety, and to ensure we conform to Government Regulations. We hope it will be a good and safe experience for you – **SO PLEASE READ** the following notes in preparation for your visit. We are all learning and changes may be made as we go forward.

1. Please ensure you are fully well, and **do not come** if you have **ANY** illness or are feeling unwell.
2. We will do all we can to keep everyone as safe as possible – and this means we rely on your co-operation. There will be clear signage and **Housekeepers** to guide and help you.
3. Your suggestions will be appreciated to make our Meeting House safe and welcoming.
4. The experience will be different and if you have any personal concerns for yourself or perhaps vulnerable members of your household, please use the contact numbers below.
5. The capacity of the Meeting House will be reduced to 20.
6. Please bring:
  - Your own bottle of water (**no access to kitchen**)
  - QF&P and A&Q (**no books etc available**)
  - **Mask to wear at all times in the MH**
  - Bag for your rubbish e.g. tissues for home disposal
  - Extra shawl/ blanket and personal cushion and keep all outdoor wear with you (**windows open for ventilation**)
7. One toilet (disabled) will be available, please use your home one beforehand.
8. Kindly note any children coming to Meetings to remain with their family.
9. Only the main Meeting Room will be used/available.

### **Arrival at Meeting House: Only arrive in time for Meeting.**

1. **Wear face mask and keep social distance as you approach (remember the passageway is narrow).**
2. **Be patient, you may have to wait for the Door Housekeeper to allow you to enter. To conform to Government track and trace regulations you will be registered (name, telephone no.). The list will be kept for 21 days in a locked place before being destroyed.**
3. **Use the Sanitiser Station or if you prefer you can be directed to wash your hands with soap and water.**
4. **A Housekeeper will direct you around the one-way system and into the Meeting Room where you will be offered a seat. Please do not change seats or move your chair.**
5. **Doors will be left open so you touch as few surfaces as possible.**

6. Should you feel unwell during Meeting, immediately inform one of the Housekeepers.
7. The length of Meeting (normally 1hr.) may vary depending on room temperature, how comfortable Friends are wearing masks etc

**After Meeting:**

1. There will be notices and a chance to share greetings (waves and smiles), but socialising will be limited.
2. There will be no refreshments so use your own bottle of water.
3. Be patient as Housekeepers will stagger the exiting, using the one-way system.
4. Remember to touch as few surfaces as possible.
5. Use the Sanitiser Station as you leave.

**Access to Toilet: Only one (the disabled) will be available and only use if really necessary.**

- Wait to be directed by a Housekeeper.
- Do not enter the toilet corridor unless the sign on the toilet door indicates 'vacant'.
- Use the Sanitiser Station at the corridor entrance.
- Change door sign to 'Engaged'
- Use disinfectant spray to clean anything you touch before and after use.
- Wash hands with soap and water.
- Change the door sign to 'Vacant'.
- Use Sanitiser Station at corridor entrance.
- Remember to give others space as you return into our small lobby.
- Use the one-way system if returning to the Meeting Room.
